


SARA Participating Institutions

Fewer than 2,500 FTE


2,500 - 9,999 FTE

S	teps for NC-SARA Data Reporting5
Fred	quently (and a Few Important but Infrequently) Asked Questions:
	Do all SARA institutions need to report their data, even if they just recently joined?7
	My institution doesn't participate in federal financial aid programs, so we don't report our enrollments to IPEDS. What should we do about reporting to NC-SARA?

Enrollment Reporting- Common Questions



 My institution just joined SARA. Do I have to submit enrollment data?

Yes, all institutions participating in SARA effective May 21, 2018 are required to report enrollment data.

What do I report?

IPEDS data submitted broken down by state. If not an IPEDS reporting institution, report the number of 100% online students participating outside the state of the institution.

No. You report military students based on the location of the learning activity. The same as all other students.

2018 Learning Placements Reporting



- Placement Reporting: Experiential learning activities (clinical rotations, student teaching, internships, etc.) are important parts of many instructional programs.
- They occur in many disciplines, but they are particularly common in certain fields, such as health-related disciplines and education.
- They are often a required part of obtaining a degree and/or license to practice a particular profession.
- Optional reporting for 2018.

Placement Reporting Guide: How to Report Out-of-State Learning Placements to NC-SARA

A Guide for SARA Institutions

Spring 2018 (PILOT YEAR)

Learning Placements



Institutions should report out-of-state placements that meet all of the following criteria:

- 1. The placement is outside the "home state" of the SARA institution;
- 2. The placement involves the physical presence of the student at the out-of-state location(s);
- 3. The placement is an activity required for degree completion (a requirement of the student's major, rather than a general institutional requirement) or professional licensure;
- 4. The placement is carried out under the provisions of a formal agreement between the institution and the placement location; and
- 5. The placement started between January 1, 2017 and December 31, 2017.

Learning Placements



Placements that meet the above criteria should be reported as follows:

- Report unduplicated headcounts;
- Disaggregated by two-digit CIP code; and
- Disaggregated by the state in which the placement was made.

Example: Three University of Texas at El Paso nursing students each do a single clinical rotation at each of two hospitals in Las Cruces, New Mexico and one rotation at a hospital in Phoenix, Arizona. UTEP would report three placements in New Mexico and three placements in Arizona, all under CIP code 51.

- What is an out-of-state learning experience?

An out-of-state learning experience refers to an internship, externship, clerkship, practicum, rotation, clinical, student teaching, independent study, study away, and the like, that occurs in a U.S. state, district or territory outside the state of the institution.

Learning PlacementsCommon Questions



 What is a formal agreement? The majority of agreements will be in writing, a contract, MOU, MOA, etc. However, some institutions may have verbal agreements. If your institution considers only written documents to be formal agreements, then only they would be your formal documents. I would suggest checking with your attorney or contract administrator for specifics.

Learning PlacementsCommon Questions



- Do I report internships?
 Yes, those meeting the five requirements.
- Do I report placement data for ALL programs, not just distance education programs?

Yes, report all program placements.
