Proposed Distance Education Federal Regulation

Timeline

- July 22: Issued new proposed regs.
- August 24: Comments due.
- October 31:
 - If issued, go into effect on July 1, 2017.
 - If issued after, go into effect July 1, 2018.
- Many new notifications and disclosures!



Proposed Distance Education Federal Regulation

"Public" Disclosures

- Programs leading to licensure or certification.
- State authorization status.
- Student complaint process in each state.
- Refunds policies required by states.
- Adverse actions in last 5 years.



Proposed Distance Education Federal Regulation

"Individualized" Disclosures

- For licensure/certification programs:
 - If enroll a student in state where don't meet requirements, student must acknowledge.
 - If new determination that don't meet state requirements in a state (within 7 days).
- Any new "adverse actions" (within 30 days).



Federal Misrepresentation Rules

- Specifically references misstatements as to state authorization or accreditation of a program. 34 CFR 668.72.
- Some accreditors/states have added misrepresentation requirements.
- State AG's and FTC now very active; their activities can be used as a basis for ED sanctions.



Federal Misrepresentation Rules

- Sanctions include possible loss of Title IV!
- Disclosure of any state and programmatic authorizations must be 100% accurate!
- Exceptionally broad and vague rules ban <u>any</u> form of "substantial misrepresentation."



Student Complaints Disclosure Rules

- Section 668.43(b) All institutions must disclose to all students, or prospective students, the complaint agency in all states where students reside.
- Complaint agencies should be posted on your website. See DCL GEN-12-13.



Student Complaints The Many Options

- State Oversight Agency
- Accrediting Agency
- Veterans...Department of Veterans Affairs
- Active duty...Department of Defense
- Private loans...Consumer Financial Protection Bureau
- Federal student loans...Department of Education



SARA Complaint Process

Student files complaint with the institution

Complaint NOT resolved at institutional level

Student may appeal to the portal entity of the (home) state in which the institution is legally domiciled



National Council for State Authorization Reciprocity Agreements

A voluntary, regional approach to state oversight of distance education Complaint resolved at institutional level

Process ends; no notification to NC-SARA

SARA Complaint

Student appeals to state portal entity Student DOES NOT appeal to state portal entity

Process ends

Institution's state portal entity notifies NC-SARA of appealed complaint AND notifies portal entity of (host) state where student is located

> *Student complaints about grades or student conduct may not be appealed to the portal agency

On quarterly basis, home state portal entities report resolution of complaint(s) to NC-SARA



SARA Disclosures

- Required state, federal, and accrediting disclosures
- Recruitment or marketing
- Tuition, fees, and other charges.
- Admissions
- Meets professional licensure requirements:
 - Meets or does not meets requirements.
 - Cannot confirm if meets requirements.



- disclosure n: something (such as information) that is made known or revealed : something that is disclosed
- disclaimer n: a statement that is meant to prevent an incorrect understanding of something (such as a book, a movie, or an advertisement)

Disclosures and Disclaimers

- Universities have many levels/types of D&D's
 - Do you know all of your institution's stakeholders and D&D's?
- Current focus for our work is on Professional Licensure compliance

- Disclosures come in many forms and more in depth,
 - Enrollment Agreements, Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), etc
- Disclaimers must be visible, accessible, and understandable
 - Website, handbooks, catalog
