What is a Special Interest Team?

- Small issue workgroup – 7 people on each team.
- Meets virtually for a period of time (as needed to address the issue).
- To discuss and research identified topics (issues of concern to SAN members).
- Team members will do independent research to contribute to the team.
- Provides deliverables as determined by The Team. Examples could include: white papers, webcasts, task list, one pagers, etc. etc.

The First two Special Interest Teams are:

1. Professional Licensure Research & Disclosures
2. Data Protection & Privacy

Our new SAN Advisory Group, which serves as representation for the members, recommended the first two interest areas. Note these are the first two of what could include other issues in the future.

How do I join a Special Interest Team?

1. Prepare an application of no more than 200 words to include:
 - Which topic you would like to join.
 - Ability to actively participate through calls and carrying out independent research to share.
 - Relevant experience with, or knowledge of, the topic.
 - Why you would like to participate on the particular Special Interest Team.
2. Send to Cheryl Dowd – cdowd@wiche.edu by January 15, 2019.
3. Applications will be reviewed, and participants chosen by the Director and Assistant Director with the advice of the SAN Advisory Group.

Teams will be named by early February.
