# Post University

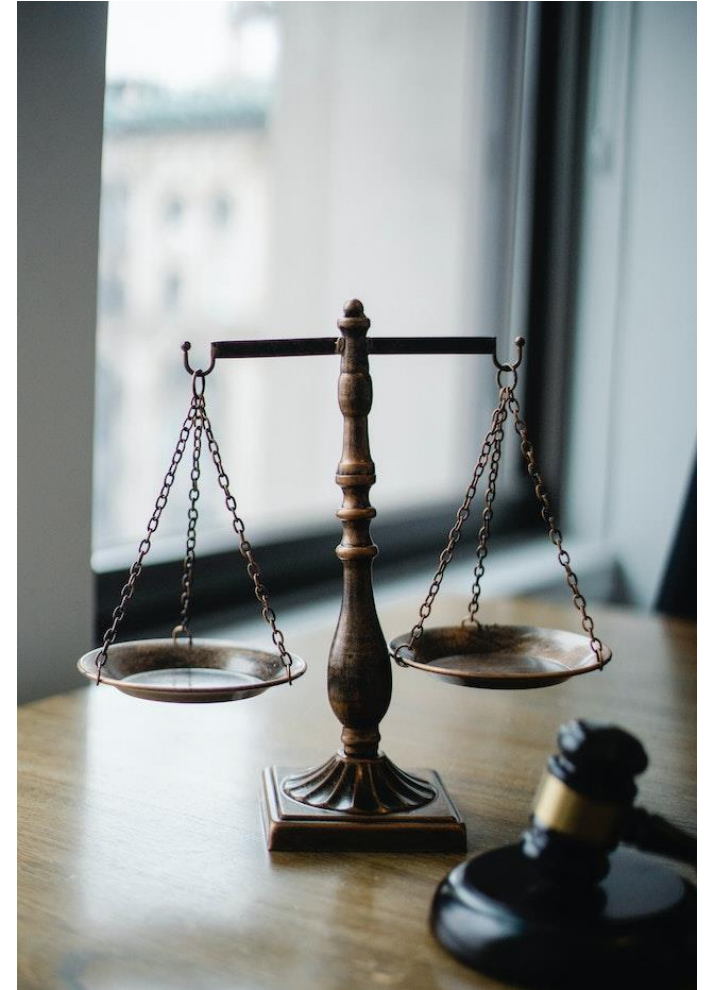


- Private, proprietary

## Three Categories of Program

- Enrollments designed to fulfill the educational requirements for licensure, or whose graduates will need licensure to work in the field related to the enrollment
- Enrollments not designed to fulfill the educational requirements for licensure, and whose graduates may or may not need licensure to work in the field related to the enrollment
- Enrollments not designed to fulfill the educational requirements for licensure, and whose graduates do not need licensure to work in the field related to the enrollment

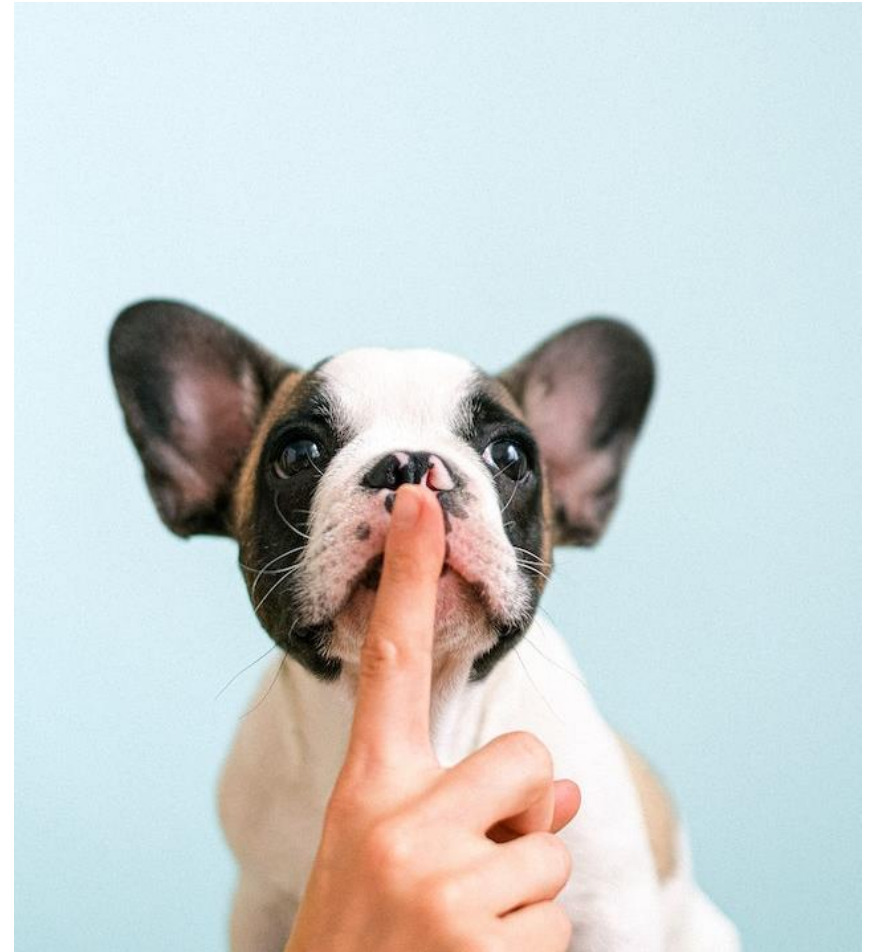
# Step 1: Data Collection



- Actively track 721 credentials
- Research thousands more each year
- Spot check before each contact

## Step 2: Channeling Students

- Admissions/advising direct the student to the programmatic page on the website or catalog
- Admissions/advising places a request with a credentialing specialist for contact





## What can I do with an Online Master's in Accounting?

Upon completion of this online master's accounting degree program, you will have had the opportunity develop skills to problem solve, communicate effectively, and think ethically.

This Master of Science in Accounting could help you explore opportunities in the fields of accounting, auditing, risk management, taxation, non-profit, and governmental accounting in any number of industries.

The Master of Science in Accounting degree may be used to partially fulfill Certified Public Accountant (CPA) education requirements. The program is not designed, however, to fulfill CPA education requirements in any specific or individual state.

- Identify ultimate goals
- Agree on career
- Establish residency
- Name the appropriate license
- Explore license requirements
- Examine Post's ability to fulfill educational requirements
- Discuss enrollment details
